

| Average Occupancy | 83.5% | | | • | Average hotel occupancy has shown a strong recovery for this quarter at 84%, almost in line with 2019 levels (85%). Occupancy has increased from 73% in Jan-Mar of this year, and from 77% during Apr-Jun last year ADR has increased by 26% since 2019, while REVPAR has increased by 23% |

Compared to 2019, occupancy levels are up 6%, active listings are up 33% and monthly RevPAR is up 66% |

On a more positive note, visits to small attractions are up 14% on last year Overall, visits to the 23 attractions in the York Attractions Monitor are 1% down on the same period last year, but still 11% below 2019 levels |






